

CROSS REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS
for taking classes at the
ACADEMY FOR JEWISH RELIGION, CALIFORNIA

The faculty is happy to announce that students at Claremont School of Theology (CST) and the Academy for Jewish Religion, California (AJR/CA) can now cross-register in certain classes at these two institutions. As the relationship between CST and AJR/CA unfolds, a few “ground rules” have been established for students and faculty to follow:

- 1) Both institutions have created a list of courses that do not have pre-requisites or that we thought would be appropriate elective classes. Check the [Class Schedules](#) page on the CST Web site for updated classes each semester. This does not mean that you can't take a class that is not on the list but it is an attempt to make it easier for you to see what courses you might have immediate access to.
- 2) Students will register at CST for any classes taken at AJR/CA. CST students must receive permission (e-mail confirmation will suffice) from the professor of the course before s/he can register. Students seeking more information and/or permission to take a class at AJR/CA should contact AJR/CA at registrar@ajrca.org. If /when a receive permission, attach a copy of the email to your CST registration form.
- 3) Members of the CST and AJR/CA faculty have full authority to decide if students from the other institution can enroll in their class and, if so, how many students from the other institution will be admitted. It is possible that that faculty person will deny permission.
- 4) AJR/CA is on a trimester system and has different start/end dates than CST. Please consult the [Academic Calendar](#) page on the CST Web site.
- 5) Since AJR/CA's courses are trimester courses and only meet for 1 hour and 45 minutes each week, their 3 unit courses will only be counted as 2 semester units. The AJR/CA [Class Schedule](#) includes the recalculated number of semester units you will receive by taking an AJR/CA class.
- 6) If there are not 5 paying AJR/CA students in a class, the class will be cancelled.
- 7) If you are a Ph.D. or D.Min. student, please check with your faculty advisor before enrolling for a class at AJR/CA.
